QUESTION: After VOCs are analyzed for the first round of sampling from the replacement well, MW-7, for the Service Store, should samples be collected in subsequent rounds? If so, should the analysis include PVOCs and naphthalene?

Answer: Groundwater monitoring wells that are to be monitored are MW-1 through MW-8 and the Backus Bulk Plant MW-7. All groundwater samples should be analyzed for PVOC's, and Naphthalene on a quarterly basis. The replacement of well MW-7 at the Heartland Coop was included in the above sampling protocol of wells MW-1 through MW-8. So yes, following the initial VOC scan of the replaced Heartland well MW-7 subsequent samples at MW-7 will be reduced and will follow the sampling protocol of PVOC's, and Naphthalene on a quarterly basis.
