Responses to Questions Related to Bid Solicitation

1. For the private wells located at 13297 W Wausau Street and 1220 Railroad Street, as well as for the new and old Feed mill wells, what are the well depths, depth to bedrock, and screened intervals?

Response: The following information was gathered from a search of Department well construction reports (WCRs):

No information concerning the construction or depths of the old feed mill well or the well serving 1220 Railroad Street was located.

2. Does the Department consider the soils investigation and remediation to be complete?

Response: While significant "soil" contaminant concentrations remained (both at and below the water table) following the soil remedial action, the Department considers this to be principally a groundwater problem at this time.

3. Has a PECFA claim been filed for this site or will the winning consultant be responsible for claiming SI costs incurred by Envirogen as well?

Response: Based on information in the Department of Commerce's tracking system, a claim for reimbursement has not been filed. It will be up to the Responsible Party to determine who will submit a claim (or claims) for reimbursement.
